



FEATURED ENTERTAINMENT AT MAJOR SPORTING EVENTS:

Additional grant of rights (optional)

1. Recorded Music NZ currently licenses sports stadiums and venues for the public performance of sound recordings at their premises. These licences cover the background use of music such as the playing in function rooms, concourses, hospitality areas, etc. It does **not** cover the use of sound recordings when they are used in a featured way during matches, for example: pre-match & half-time entertainment, or breaks in play due to injury or the reset of play.
2. Recorded Music NZ has identified featured use of sound recordings at sports events as an area where blanket licensing may be of use to our members in ensuring that their copyright is adequately protected from unauthorised use.
3. In this letter **Featured Entertainment at Major Sporting Events** means the Communication of Sound Recordings and/or Music Videos at specific times or occurrences directly before and during sports events.
4. By signing this optional, non-exclusive mandate you are granting Recorded Music NZ the right to represent, and licence on your behalf, your Controlled Content if and when it is used as Featured Entertainment at Major Sporting Events. *[NB: If there are specific artists or tracks within your Controlled Content that you wish to exclude from such licensing, please detail these on a separate page and attach to your executed Acceptance Form.]*
5. The Licensing Scheme developed by Recorded Music NZ for Featured Entertainment at Major Sporting Events will be determined at Recorded Music NZ's sole discretion, provided that Recorded Music NZ has first established and published a Licensing Scheme for the use named above, and which has been approved by its Board of Directors.
6. For the avoidance of doubt the terms, conditions, expressions and clauses of the Recorded Music NZ Input Agreement apply mutatis mutandis to this letter.
